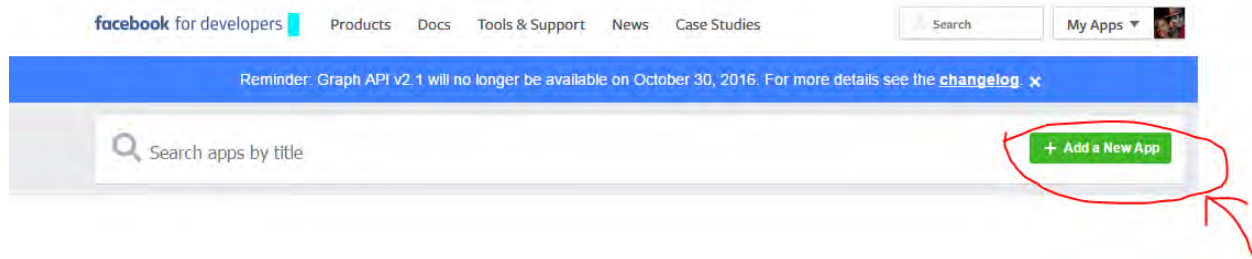

Create Facebook App Instructions

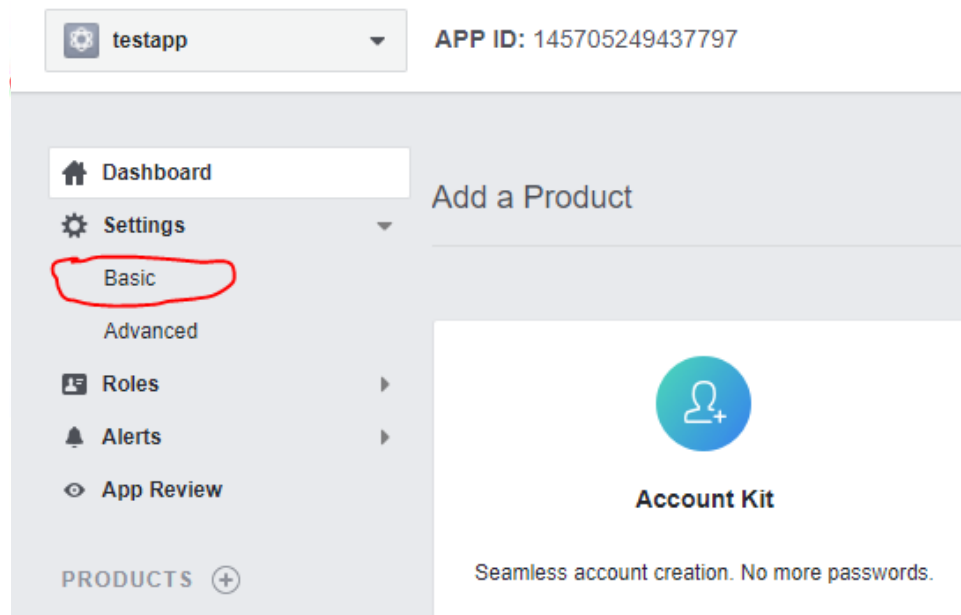
1. Go to <https://developers.facebook.com/apps> and click the “Add a New App” button.



2. Enter a Display Name, your contact email.

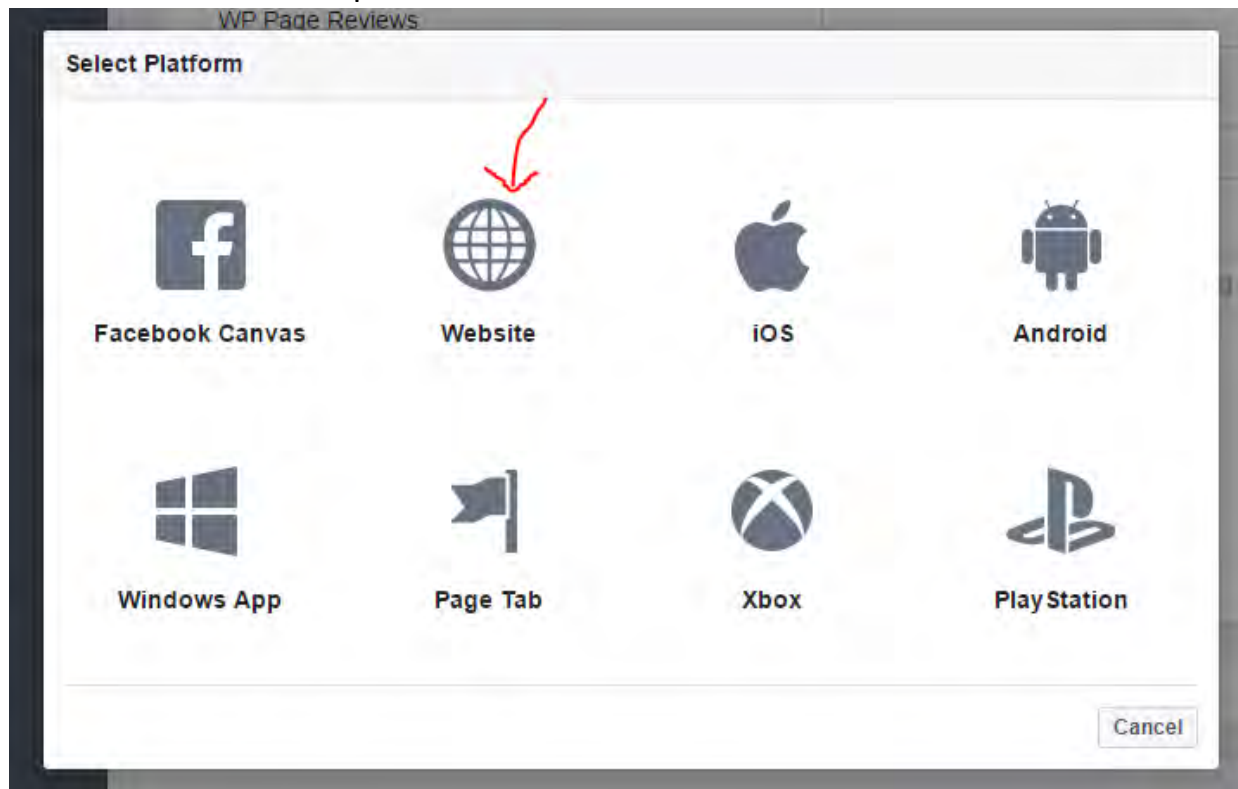
3. Click the "Create App ID" then fill in the Security Check captcha and click submit.

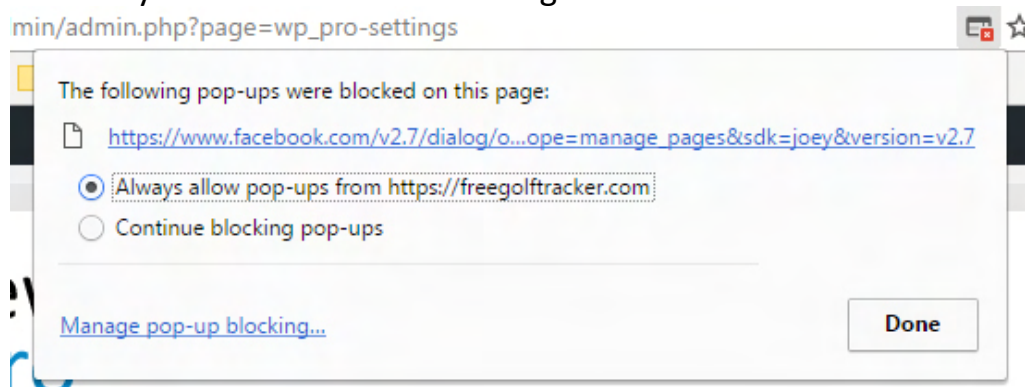
The first thing you need to do is create a Facebook application that this plugin will communicate with below to go to the Facebook developer site and create an application. Click on the instructions button

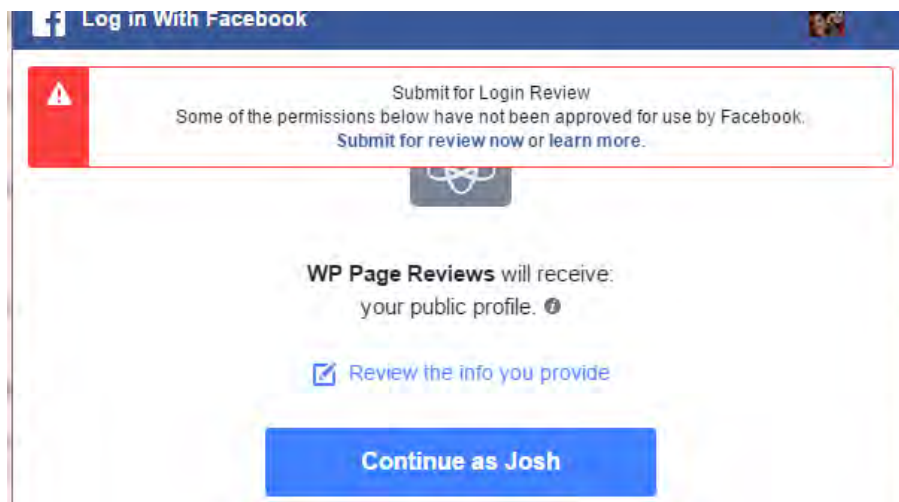

12. Now back in the Plugin Settings click the “Save Settings” button again or refresh the page, you should get a list of Pages that you manage.
